
PURPOSE

The engagement campaign ‘Healthy Conversation 2019’ took place during March to October 2019 and was delivered by all of the Lincolnshire NHS organisations together. This was an open engagement exercise to shape how the NHS in Lincolnshire takes health care forward in the years ahead. It was a chance for everyone to learn more about the NHS’s current thinking on the future of NHS services and a way to get meaningful feedback from our patients, their representatives, the public, NHS partners and staff about what future services may look like.

Healthy Conversation 2019 continued throughout the year, with a wide range of engagement events and discussions across the county. Almost seven months of engagement came to a close on 31st October 2019 and has enabled all feedback received to be considered in a timely manner and informed the Lincolnshire’s Long Term Plan, alongside the Healthwatch engagement results. Feedback has also been reported into system programmes as well as shaping emerging options for the Acute Services Review consultation.
