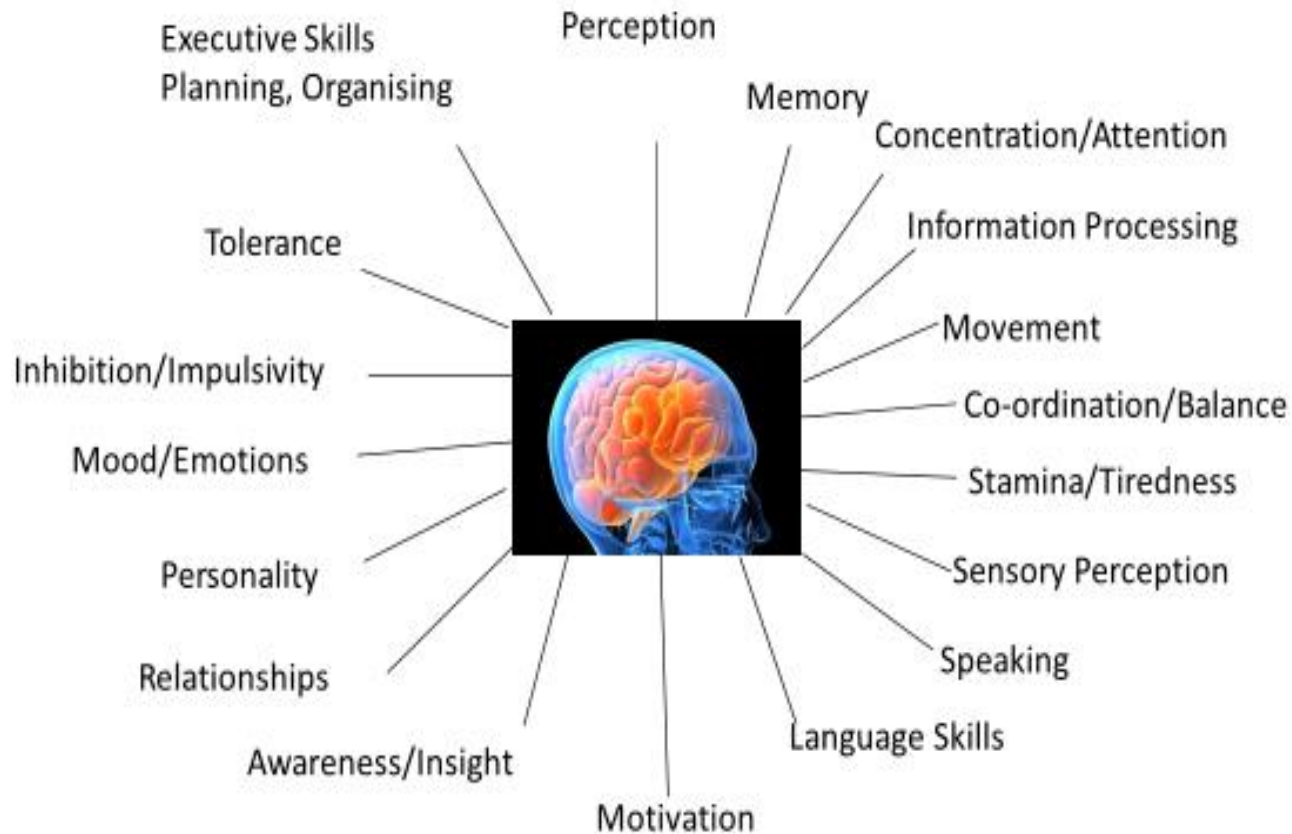
What do we do?

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Effects of an Acquired Brain Injury

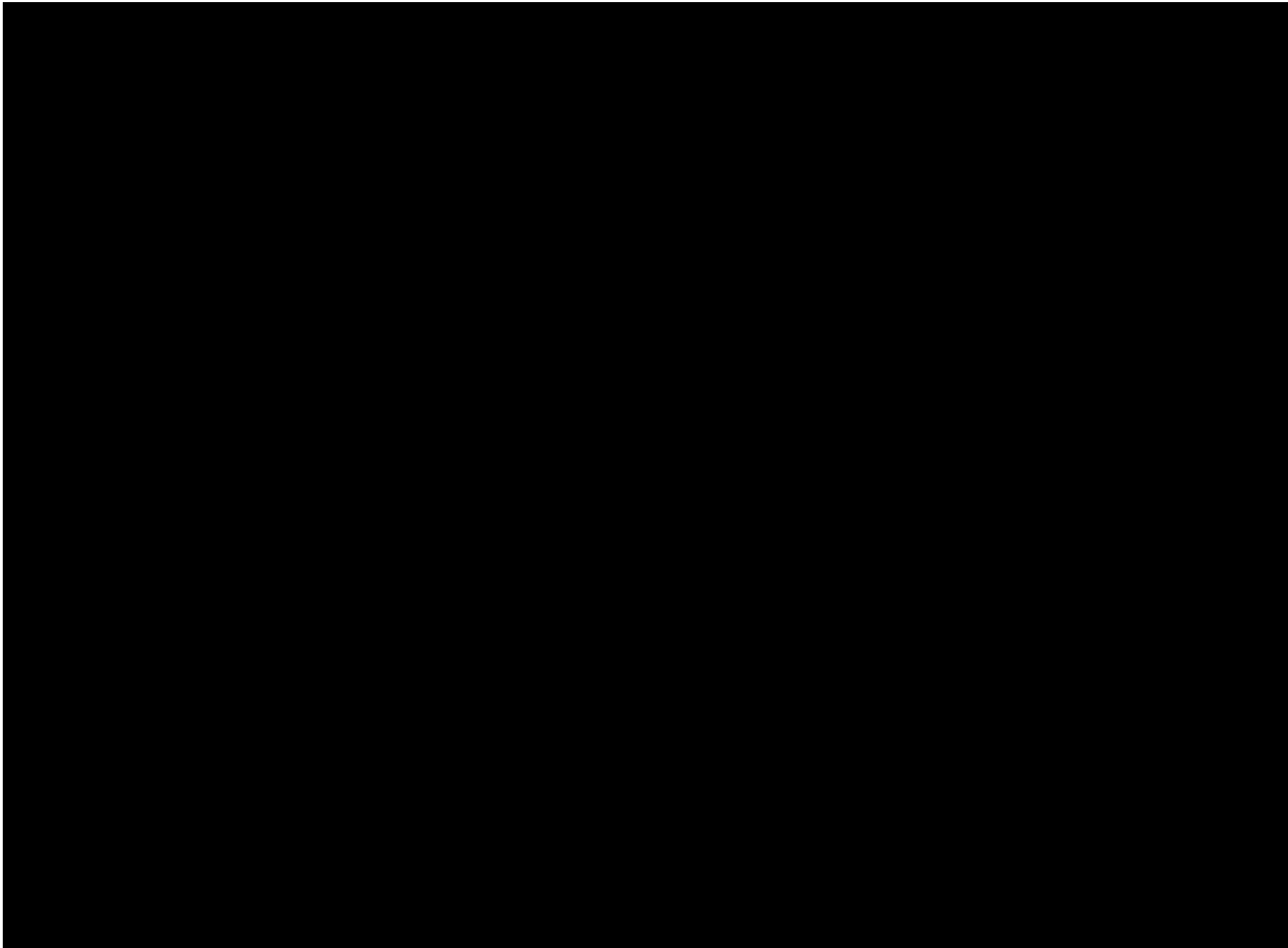




“I was able to attend meetings at Headway Lincolnshire and it was encouraging to be around people who were going through similar things to me. I knew then that I wasn’t alone.”
